State Funding Reform Act of 2014

What you should **know**

- ▶ If enacted into law, Senate Bill 16 (SB16) will **redistribute state funding** among school districts in Illinois.
- ▶ SB 16 will **take funding from districts with higher assessed property values** like Barrington 220, and provide more money to districts with lower income from property taxes.

Potential **Barrington 220** impact

- ▶ State funding would be cut by **49 percent**, or **\$5.4 million** per year.
- ▶ Barrington 220 would see the **16th largest drop** in funding in Illinois
- ▶ Barrington 220 would experience the **biggest decrease** in state funds among all school districts in Lake County.
