I am writing to provide you with more information regarding BHF LLC, also known as Barrington Hills Farm, and our upcoming plans.

As you know, Barrington Hills Farm purchased the site formerly known as Strathmore Organic Farms in the fall of 2014, and has since committed to maintaining a substantial portion of this property as open space land. In accordance with this commitment, we partnered with the Hooved Animal Rescue & Protection Society of Barrington, Illinois ("HARPS") in anticipation of providing educational seminars for horse owners and a home for HARPS rescue horses.

We are very excited to announce Barrington Hills Farm is progressing to the next phase of this partnership. We are now in the process of securing a building permit for the HARPS barn that will be hosted on Barrington Hills Farm. The barn will be positioned on a twenty-acre parcel of nearly 602-acre property. McHenry County has conditionally approved the building permit and we are working with the county and our architects to ensure all plans are in compliance with this conditional approval.

We look forward to engaging with you as neighbors, and hope you will benefit from the great services HARPS and Barrington Hills Farm seek to provide our community. As we continue to move forward with this process, please know we are committed to being good and conscientious neighbors and are excited to maintain and enhance our shared vision for this community.
