2023 Road Program

Ekstrom reviewed the purpose of the meeting is to consider roads for next year's repaving program. She reported that she had studied a lot of data prior to this meeting and reviewed some of the road programs recent history.

Ekstrom reported that she received the Roadbotics map from several years ago where a camera drove and rated the roads. After the analysis the results were compared to that of the Engineers report and found the results matched well. The Village will be utilizing Roadbotics again this year.

Ekstrom reviewed that she believes we should be paving 3.5 miles a year based on her calculations using the historical data available to her. Last year the Village resurfaced a little over a mile, she recommends increasing the amount resurfaced this year.

Cecola stated that he disagrees with the practice of paving on a schedule no matter the condition of the road.

Cieslica reviewed that patching greatly extends the life of the roads, even if it isn't attractive. People might not like the way it looks but if it gets 5 or 6 more years out of the road, it is a huge savings. He also stated that he believes that the Villages roads are incredible compared to other communities.

Ekstrom stated that Cuba Road, from the bridge to route 14 seems to be degrading quickly, putting it ahead of Spring Creek and Braeburn in her opinion.

The committee had a robust discussion on which roads should be resurfaced.

Ultimately it was concluded that Oak Knoll Road and the eastern portion of Cuba Road were to be resurfaced, if the budget allows. The Village is still considering whether to CRF Dana Lane, Caesar Drive, and Three Lakes Road.
