DRAFT Meeting Minutes

Seasonal Road Closure Recommendation

Village Engineer Cieslica reported that frost is appearing and that the Village typically posts the road closure in March. The engineers test for frost; two inches of frost was measured the previous week. Roads close for about 30 days. The effective date is March 10, 2025.

Road Program 2025 Recommendation

Cieslica summarized the two spreadsheets attached to the recommendation letter: one is the base bid, and the other is an alternate which includes Buckley Road. The bid includes resurfacing Spring Creek Road up to Meadow Hill Road. A third page is for Reclamite. He shared that he is pleased with the bids received.

Trustee Ekstrom shared that the budget accommodates the full Reclamite plan. She proceeded to read the bid proposal summaries and stated the Village focused on Builders Paving because they had the best bid and that the Village has had a good experience with them. Cieslica added that they used to be Orange Crush who has previously done work for the Village.

Trustee Ekstrom touched upon the Reclamite bid reporting that it included many roads in addition to the roads paved last year and proceeded to state all the roads included. Cieslica shared that it's important to add a second application. Trustee Ekstrom shared that Reclamite is a proven method for road preservation.

Administrator Paul shared that the Reclamite is applied in the fall, of which the road program should be either completed or near completion. Cieslica added that the pricing we receive depends on the time of year and he explained the pricing process.

Before voting, Trustee Ekstrom clarified that the vote did not include the Reclamite application as that will be reassessed after the completion of the road program.

The Committee voted to recommend Builders Paving.

Overweight Permit Fee Discussion

President Cecola recommended the Village raise its overweight fees, expressing that the current fee is 20 plus years old. The Village is currently reevaluating all of its fees and overweight fees should be reassessed as well. He would like to see the fee raised to \$100 per trip.

Trustee Ekstrom reported that 122 permits were issued, excluding those issued with a building permit.

Discussion ensued between Trustee Ekstrom and President Cecola around the process for determining overweight fees, including looking into Oxcart's recommendation, Rutger's study for truck permits, general contracting fees, pricing options, and how our village compares to other Villages' overweight fees.

Cieslica shared that state highways are concrete and built to certain standards, and county roads are built close to those standards; Village roads are not built to those standards. Overweight trucks on local streets do more damage than they do on state or county roads.

Trustee Ekstrom would like to gather additional information before making a final decision.

Attached is a spreadsheet containing street segments along with estimated resurfacing costs for the 2025 Road Program. By using this spreadsheet and its estimated costs, we recommend the following streets for consideration for the 2026 Road Program.
