**Road Program 2026 Discussion**

The Committee reviewed potential resurfacing projects for the 2026 Road Program and recommended including the east portion of Spring Creek Road and Rock Ridge Road. Hawthorne Lane may be added as an alternate if pricing allows.

The Village will continue the use of Reclamite to extend pavement life. The Committee also discussed performing crack sealing in 2026 and requested an estimate for the additional cost of using a grooved-in striping product with longer durability.

Ekstrom noted that the Equestrian Commission identified locations where additional signage may be warranted and others where existing signs require maintenance. Administration will review these locations with the Police Department and the Village Engineer, proceed with installations as appropriate, and complete necessary maintenance in the spring.
